




A - Rapping with the Vikings

The camp "Rapping with the Vikings" is arranged by MD106A and will be situated in the Northern part of Zealand, and area which contains some of the richest nature in Denmark and a lot of cultural traces, leading back to the history of the early Danes. The maximum capacity of the camp is 35 participants in the age range of 17-21 years, both included, and the YCE Fee for participation is €100.



The camp activities will involve, inter alia

- Excursion to the city of Roskilde with
 - visit to Roskilde Cathedral, the royal burial church for centuries and now is part of the UNESCO World Heritage because of its unique architecture, and
 - visit to the Viking Ship Museum, including demonstration of the tools used by the Vikings and sailing with a replica of a Viking ship.
- Excursion to Copenhagen, the capital of Denmark, including sailing through the city canals by small self-driven boats.
- Teambuilding participants should be prepared to tell their fellow campers about themselves and their country.

The camp will take place 12-26 July 2025 and will be preceded by home stay 28 June – 12 July for overseas participants and 5-12 July for European participants.

B - No Borders between People

The camp "No Borders between People" is arranged by MD106B and will be situation in the far Northern part of Jutland, just at the border between to seas surrounding Denmark: The North Sea and The Kattegat – hence the camp theme indicating that while borders must exist between waters, no such borders should exist between people. The maximum capacity of the camp is 24 participants in the age range of 17-21 years, both inclusive, and the YCE Fee for participation is €100.

The camp activities will include, inter alia

- Visit to a major modern Danish agricultural business.
- Visit to Arla, the biggest Danish business for production of dairy products.
- A day of insight in the Danish windmill industry which produces the main part of the Danish consumption of electrical energy.
- Teambuilding participants should be prepared to tell their fellow campers about themselves and their country.

The camp will take place 12-26 July 2025 and will be preceded by home stay 28 June – 12 July for overseas participants and 5-12 July for European participants.
